## **Project Proposal Presentation Guidelines (T\_4172)**

This guide is to help students prepare for their project proposal presentations T\_4172.

The presentation for the T\_4172 project proposal will start on Week 14 (July 3 - 10, 2023).

The proposal presentation will be conducted **face-to-face**, and the duration of the presentation will be in **20** minutes, including the **question-and-answer session**.

## A. Presentation slide preparation.

- 1. Each student is required to prepare PowerPoint slides for presentation purposes.
- 2. The language used is Malay (except for international students).
- 3. Slides should contain (but not be limited to):
  - a. Project introduction.
  - b. Research problems.
  - c. Research objectives.
  - d. Suggested solutions (designs and specifications).
  - e. Demonstration of prototype/initial implementation (if any)
  - f. Conclusion.
- **4.** The number of slides should correspond to the duration of the presentation, within **15** minutes.

## B. The day before the presentation

- 1. Check the examiner's name in SPID or UKMFolio.
- 2. Contact your examiner to get confirmation of the time and location of the presentation according to the decision made by the examiner.
- 3. Make sure you are ready to present.

## C. On the day of the presentation

- 1. Ensure you are at the location 10 minutes before the presentation.
- 2. Make sure to dress appropriately for the presentation.
- 3. When presenting, check your time you are given 20 minutes to present, including a question-and-answer session.
- 4. The examiner will ask more about your proposal during the question-and-answer session. Therefore, make sure you are prepared with materials that feel appropriate to explain more about your proposal (if asked).
- 5. The examiner will also assess your ability to answer the questions in addition to the presentation and proposal report (D5).
